I-BEST Integrated Basic Education & Skills Training

One in every six Washington adults lacks the literacy skills needed to obtain a job paying livable wages, according to the Washington State Board for Community and Technical Colleges. Columbia Basin College's I-BEST courses combine professional-technical classes with basic skills and English-literacy to excel students toward a high-demand job with a livable wage.



I-BEST OVERVIEW

The Integrated Basic Education & Skills Training (I-BEST) program at CBC provides educational access and support for Adult Basic Education (ABE)/English as a Second Language (ESL) students to progress further and faster along career pathways.



CURRICULUM

I-BEST pairs ABE/ESL and professional-technical instructors in the classroom to advance students in both basic and professional-technical skills. Classes are specific to programs that build toward degrees and/or certificates leading to high-demand jobs, while offering integrated instruction and additional assistance with homework, projects, and test preparation. Through the I-BEST program, students can transition easily from basic skills to other programs on campus.



PROGRAMS

Programs and class schedules vary each quarter and often include both lecture and lab instruction. Examples of programs offered by I-BEST include a one-quarter Certified Nursing Assistant (NAC) program in the Health Sciences Pathway, a two-quarter Phlebotomy program in the Health Sciences Pathway, and a two-quarter Child Development Associate (CDA) program in the Early Childhood Education Pathway.
